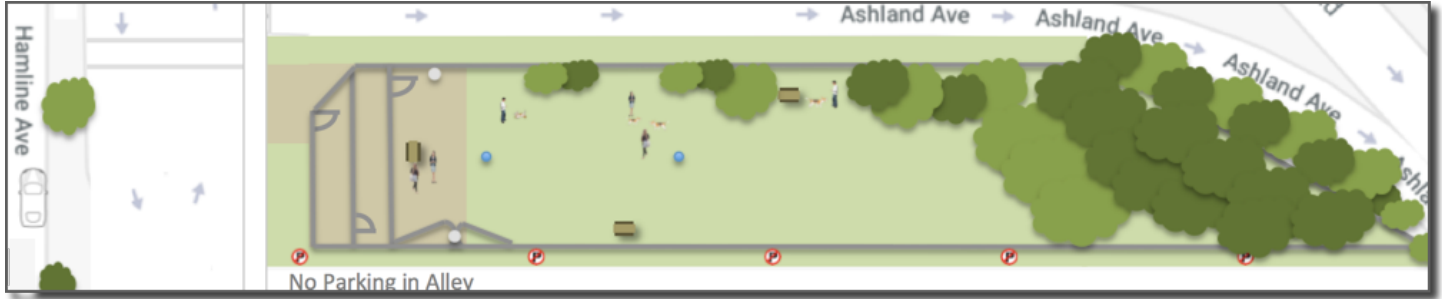




Community Dog Field Proposal



The Proposed Location is the parcel at Hamline Avenue North and Ashland Avenue.

Parking is available on the Hamline frontage road. No parking is allowed in the alley per St. Paul parking rules.

The Proposed Hours are Sunday through Saturday, sunrise to sunset.

The Dog Field is Designed for Small Dogs (under 30 lbs.) due to: land space, existing fencing size and cost for new fencing, dog safety, maintenance costs, insurance, and community funding. (Large dogs may use High Bridge Dog Park.)

Funding for the Community Dog Field would come from donations and sponsorships.

Safety Features:

- Ornamental fence with large signage at entrance
- Long entry corridor with 3 gates for dog safety
- Street-crossing flags
- Signage 1 block north and south on Hamline Ave.

Additional Features:

- Kiosk for announcements, schedule, rules, events, etc.
- Plastic bag holders
- Trash receptacles
- Picnic tables and water bowls

Proposed Community Dog Field Rules:

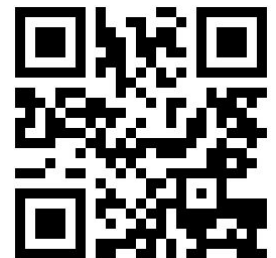
- Guardians must clean up and dispose of pet waste.
- Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and upon leaving the off-leash area and in transition corridors.
- Guardians must be in verbal control of their dogs to prevent aggressive behavior and excessive barking.
- Guardians are liable for damage or injury inflicted by their dog.
- Dogs must be licensed and vaccinated.
