### 1. Agenda and Minutes

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#### 2. Follow-ups and UPDC updates

- UPDC news:
  - Board retreat in December
  - New at-large person tenant advocacy and association
  - Next CLUED meeting about sound permit
    - Ward 4 asked for feedback
  - Election at the Spruce Tree Center, conference room
  - New Staff member (Ariana)
  - New business: Hot Works (filled vacancy across from United Village)
- Started with invitations on people that lived closest to intersection (UPDC task force on Snelling & University)
- Discussions on new Abby, new UPDC staff member who is very enthusiastic about the neighborhood

#### 3. Bicycle Benefits (Ian - Bicycle Benefits, Ember - Our Streets)

- Amy Gage introductions, has been in touch with Ember for a while
- Ian reached out to Amy, said that this needs to get going again
- lan:
  - a. Worked with businesses that want to provide benefits to customers who bike there
  - b. Wear a sticker on their helmet
  - c. Put on a bike bingo event
  - d. Still receives orders for stickers, despite program being largely spun down, maybe because businesses still acknowledge it
  - e. Is a collaborative effort

- Ember:
  - a. Minneapolis Bicycle Coalition was previous iteration of Our Streets
  - b. One challenge we've had with getting program going again is that

  - d. Would like to be on the ground facilitator
  - e. Could use help with outreach and getting businesses interested
  - f. Connects bicyclists with participating businesses
  - g. Taking postcards to businesses around takes businesses to website with form
- Amy: should we ask to talk to owner or manager? Ember: yes, that's best
- Barb: what is the discount? Is it consistent across businesses?
  - a. Lisa: it varies depending on the business

- April: could we add this to the potential "new UPDC business" kit?
  - a. Ian: a lot of businesses might be interested and might have limited capacity, so this might best empower businesses
- Ember: at Our Streets, we have canvassers that go out and talk to people
- Ember: in the interim, you have the postcards, and please communicate with us
- Amy: Can our District Council get you information in a more consistent way?
  a. Ember: Yes, we also want to make it so that volunteers can take it and go
- Ian: Twin Cities is huge, struggles to get visibility with the program
- Lisa: Might be helpful to loop in other Saint Paul organizations
  - a. If we can get this working for our DC, we can go to others (sustain stp, saint paul bicycle coalition)
  - b. Midway Chamber of Commerce might be a good stop
- Ian: organizations and institutions will often purchase from us at cost
- Jim: do you use bike shops? lan: that's a great idea
- Ian: we need to make it easy on businesses, to find something exciting for cyclists and easy for them
- Ian: focus on local businesses and not larger ones (e.g. whole foods)
- Ember: Would appreciate connection with bicycle coalition
- Lisa: Amy can report back on bicycle coalition connection

# 4. Other updates

- Some language about drive throughs is making to city language (walk up windows)
  a. Leah resubmitted our letter to city staff to public hearing, to go onto public record
- April contacted public works about what's happening with the concordia sidewalks, will hopefully hear back soon
- Public hearing on drive throughs is on Wednesday
- Barb: MnDOT finally posted videos of land bridge (Denver) and highway-to-boulevard (Syracuse) can we send email to committee and transportation list and Mitra?
  - a. Add this to UPDC newsletter
- Allen: Pelham Reconstruction
  - a. Ground Round
  - b. Separated bikeway similar plan on Wheelock Parkway?
- ICPBJ topics (concerns about transportation)
  - a. 30 responses, covering vehicle traffic, sidewalks, train safety, bike infrastructure, bus connections, and car infrastructure
  - b. Mac-Groveland survey follow-up
- 2024 Work Plan
  - a. If we do or don't want to do things on the work plan, we should alter it
