



Welcome,

Please share this important information with all of the staff coordinating this event and the bus drivers.

The buses for this event are to go and drop-off at the Flynn Turnaround on North Campus. For everyone's safety **please follow these instructions** and do not deviate.

Please do not use the Summit address for St. Thomas. This will take you to the wrong location. There is one main address for the campus.

The Flynn Turnaround is located in front of the Flynn Residence Hall just south of the intersection of Selby and Finn Avenues. Buses are to **pull in to the turnaround** to drop off guests. Please don't use the city street or the drive aisle because of the heavy traffic and the possibility of impeding the traffic.

The map below indicates the walking route to the event's location. When guests are dropped-off, the bus must leave campus. There is **no bus parking** on the University of St. Thomas Campus or in the general area. I am very sorry.

I know it is tempting to use Cleveland Ave., Summit Ave., or some other nearby location. Most of these are no parking areas or not designed for buses. Also, these are sites present safety issues. The university wants to protect pedestrians crossing the street, bicyclists using the dedicated lanes, and vehicle drivers from going into opposing traffic or having their views obstructed. It is just common sense not to park elsewhere.

Additionally, there is restricted city permit parking within about a 6 block range of the campus. Out of respect for our neighbors, I **ask you NOT park on Cretin Ave., Summit Ave., Grand Ave., Cleveland Ave., or any other residential street in the neighborhood**, even if permit parking is not enforced at this time. Around campus there are Metro Transit bus stops. Parking is **not allowed** at these stops because they are reserved only for city buses. Violations may result in a visit by St. Paul Police Parking Enforcement.

After your drop-off, I suggest you proceed north on Cretin Ave. to University, two blocks north of I 94. There are shopping areas with parking and restaurants. (See map)

The group leader needs to call for the bus when the group is ready to be picked-up and again only at the Flynn Turnaround. This will prevent waiting or staging which is not possible because of the small area.
